Art

(Lead Subject)

In Art we will be exploring the concept of Form, how artist use different tones of the same colour to create the illusion of light and depth in different media. We will be looking at the sculptures and pottery of Sandy Brown including a visit to her studio. We will be using film and photography to create our own sculptures using tone and publishing them on a website ready for Fremington Art Festival.

RE

(Enhancement subject)

In R.E, we will be investigating what was the impact of Pentecost for Christians and how do festivals and worship show what matters to a Muslim?

PSHE (Enhancement subject)

In PSHE this term we will be looking at Relationships. We will explore feelings within relationships such as love and jealousy. It will support the children to learn how to deal with negative emotions within relationships and how to recognise positive and healthy relationships with others. This involves discussing friendship skills such as assertiveness, negotiation and compromise.

ENGLISH

(Enhancement subject)

In English, we will start the term looking at Dare to care: Pet Dragon. We will be focusing on using a range of conjunctions and adverbials to help us extend and explain our ideas.

We will then move on to look at Once upon a Rain Drop that links with our Science topic on the water cycle. We will focus on the fronted adverbials and prepositions.

Music Children will learn about the origin and features of rock and roll music, they will learn how to play music such as Rock Around the Clock, looking specifically at a walking bass line, before then performing a piece as a class.



CLASS STORY

Our class novel this term will be I, Cosmo by Carlie Sorosiak. The stories of one dog's attempt to save his family, become a star, and eat a lot of bacon. Cosmo's family is falling apart. And it's up to Cosmo to keep them together.

MATHS

In Maths, we will be following our mastery approach using the ready to progress criteria to deliver high quality mathematics lessons. We will be continuing to use fluency and number talk to support the children's mental maths development.

PE

In P.E. this term, we will be looking at Cricket and the skills we need to play the game effectively and successfully. Children will also be swimming in groups starting with Falcons after Easter and then Hawks after June half term. We will also be exploring Dance and movement.

SCIENCE

In science this term we are looking at materials, we will be comparing and grouping materials, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases. We will look at these elements within the water cycle.

In habitats and life cycles we will look at how living things can be classified. Identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment. We will construct and interpret different food chains,
