## HISTORY (Lead Subject)

Our History this year focuses on answering the question "Do Historical Objects belong in their Country of Origin?" This enquiry has a focus on the concepts of Responsibility, Conflict, Trust, that we link to other subjects as you can see.


Throughout this unit of study, the children will learn about the Ancient Greece and particularly the Elgin Marbles and what they can tell us about life in Ancient Greece

- 1) Why were Museums created and how they are responsible for looking after historical artefacts
- 2) Who was Lord Elgin and why did he take the Marbles
- 3) Should the Elgin Marbles be returned to Greece

## RESPONSIBILITY

### RE (Enhancement subject)

In RE the children will be looking at the concept of 'responsibility by studying how and why do we mark the significant events of life? Also how do festivals and family life show what matters to Jewish people?



## TRUST

### PSHE (Enhancement subject)

In PSHE, the children will be learning 2 units of work through our 'Jigsaw' PSHE programme of study. The first is entitled "Being Me" and looks at aspects such as our responsibilities in the school community. The second is entitled "Celebrating Differences" it looks at lessons on bullying and also how we can judging and making assumptions about people on the way they look'

## CONFLICT

### ENGLISH (Enhancement subject)

English for this term we will initially focus on A Greek Myth based on Theseus and the Minotaur and an explanation text based on Gut Garden – A Journey into the Wonderful World of your Microbiome.

### PE

This term the children will have a swimming sessions starting with Falcon's in the first term. Outside P.E. will be learning how to play cricket.

## CLASS STORY

Our class story this term is the fantastic story entitled "Who Let the Gods Out" by Maz Evans.

### MATHS

In Maths, we will be following our mastery approach using the ready to progress criteria to deliver high quality mathematics lessons. We will be continuing to use fluency and number talk to support the children's mental maths development, as well as pre-teach for those that find Maths a little difficult.

The main focus of the year will be preparing children in learning all their times tables ready for the Government Assessment in summer.

### SCIENCE

Science for this term has two areas of study. In Autumn 1 the children will be learning about the human internal organs and investigating teeth and how we can care for them. In the second half of the term we will be looking at life cycles of different animals and how they are dependent on different eco systems for survival.
