## DINNER TICKETS

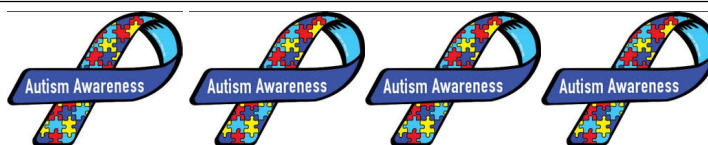
Please pay for dinner tickets using Parent Pay –
