Dear Parents & Carers,

Thank you for all your support during these very challenging times. A few reminders for you all:

- We work very hard to keep all of our bubbles separate in school- please help us by arriving after 8.50am when the gates open to avoid groups of children in different bubbles in a big group outside the gates.
- Remember that if anyone in your household shows symptoms, the whole household must isolate pending a test result- please don't send siblings to school
- If you or your child has been advised to self-isolate due to having close contact with a positive case, they must do so for 14 days, irrespective of a negative test or not.
- Please let us know the results of covid tests as soon as you have them regardless of if they are negative or not.
